Corrado Finardi, with a PhD in Agri-food Economics, a Master's degree in organizational studies and another in International Cooperation (Madrid), has some 15 years of experience in regulatory affairs and consultancy on food safety and nutrition, more specifically in aspects at the boundary of science, economics and law.

In his previous roles, he took part in the drafting of several legislative acts at the European Union (novel food, cloning, official controls, and more) and national (Italy) level (origin labeling, traceability) as well as in Public Consultations of the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA), for which he contributed to develop the present mechanism of transparency of comments delivered inside the public consultation tool.

He has been appointed in the Stakeholders Consultative Group on Emerging Risks (STACGER) of the European Food Safety Authority. He contributed to the FAO definition of "Sustainable Food System" in 2010 and cooperated with FAO-UNEP on several initiatives since 2010 and to date, as well as with OECD and several Codex Alimentarius WGs.

As a consultant, he can support big, medium and small enterprises in the technical regulation for marketing approval on the EU market in the domain of novel foods, food additives, food contact materials, food labeling health claims, organic products and functional foods, as well as HACCP and food safety management systems.

He writes regularly for several journals specialized in food law and food safety, either national or international peer reviewed ones.
